THE GENESIS AND ESTABLISHMENT OF IDS.

- Established in 1981, named in honor of the late Archbishop St Janani Luwum as a theological college
- The college has progressed from training theology to development to respond to the development challenges in the region

IDS proposed mode of operation

- Offering distance learning to development practitioners in the region
- Promote local knowledge and experience in addressing development issue in the region (e.g. Mato Oput (drinking of bitter herbs), Gomo Tong (bending spears), Kayo cuk (bitting charcoal), in mediation, arbitration and human rights protection.
- Linkages with other academic institutions within the region and globally

Mode of operation

- Out reach to build capacities amongst parents, teachers, children in and out of schools
